Referendum Election Details

At an election to be held in the City of Racine on April 1st, 2025, the following proposed referendum will be submitted to a vote of the people:

Ballot Text

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

Under state law, the increase in the levy of the City of Racine for the tax to be imposed for the next fiscal year, 2026, is limited to .679% which results in a levy of \$59,288,390. Shall the City of Racine be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the next fiscal year, 2026, and on an ongoing basis for the purpose of enhancing, strengthening and equipping those Emergency Medical Services personnel for the Citizens of Racine by retaining Paramedics and Emergency Medical Technicians by a total of 2.53%, which results in a levy of \$60,788,390 and on an ongoing basis include the increase of \$1,500,000 for each fiscal year going forward?

Explanation

A “yes” vote on the Question would indicate support for increasing the levy for the purpose of enhancing, strengthening and equipping those Emergency Medical Services personnel for the Citizens of Racine by retaining Paramedics and Emergency Medical Technicians.

A “no” vote on the Question would indicate opposition to increasing the levy for the purpose of enhancing, strengthening and equipping those Emergency Medical Services personnel for the Citizens of Racine by retaining Paramedics and Emergency Medical Technicians.
