## **Steps to Start**

- 1. Market Research
  - a. <u>Small Business Development Center</u> can help you learn what you need from Market Research
- 2. Business Plan

A Business Plan will be needed to ask for investors' support and bank loans.

# 3. Funding

- a. Connecting with the <u>Small Business Development Center</u> will help you prepare to apply for a business loan with a bank
- b. Other organizations will help with financing
  - i. List Start In Wisconsin Small Business Development Center
- c. Business loans often require a 20% down payment.
- d. If this is an expansion you may have more resources available. When contacting the <u>Small Business Development Center</u> make sure they know this is an expansion of an existing business.
- 4. Legal Structure, Name, Register your Business, Tax ID
  - a. The <u>Small Business Development Center</u> can help you learn what you need to decide which legal structure is best for you. They will also help you choose a name and register that name, if available, and set up your Tax ID.

### 5. Bank Account
